Turning Negative Report into Positive Report

lory be to God Almighty—the One who was, who is, and who is to come. There is none like Him; none can be compared to Him.

You are about to be exposed to "The Truth, Nothing but the Truth." And the Bible declares, "You shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." (John 8:32) By the power of the Spirit of God, may this message impact your heart with truth. As you read, connect to the Spirit of God, connect to the Spirit of Truth, because you will need truth to help you walk in freedom.

I believe there are many of you reading this whom God is about to speak to. Perhaps you've been praying over something specific—expect God to speak to you now through this message. May He impact your mind, touch your soul, and give you clear direction for your current situation.

Message Introduction

This is the message God gave me: "Turning Negative Report into Positive Report."

How can a negative report be turned into a positive one? You must first understand that life operates in two dimensions:

- 1. The spiritual
- 2. The physical

Each has a profound effect on your life—but the spiritual dimension carries greater authority. Why? Because the spiritual realm determines what manifests in the physical. The physical is merely a reflection of what has been decided spiritually. This is why many of you are not experiencing favor—because your spiritual dimension hasn't released the result needed to activate favor in the physical.

The Face: An Evidence of the Spiritual

When someone wants to favor you, they often look at your face—which is a visible reflection of your spiritual atmosphere. Ask yourself: "Is my face favorable in the spirit?" Whatever is spoken in the spirit determines what manifests physically. You may have received:

- A medical diagnosis (negative report)
- A rejection letter (negative report)
- A marital delay (negative report)
- A career setback (negative report)

All these are physical manifestations. But what matters most is: What has God said about you.

Understanding the Role of the Spirit

Most negative reports arise in the physical. But if you're going to cancel or reverse a negative report, it must be done from the spiritual realm. That's why your relationship with God is so

important. You must know God's mind concerning your life, so that when negative news comes, you're not shaken. Instead, you ask: "What is God saying about this?"

Why Prayer May Not Always Change the Situation Immediately

Sometimes, when you pray, and nothing changes, it's because what you're experiencing has already been permitted in the spirit for a purpose. So, when you cry out, "Father, I reject this report!" The Spirit checks: "Was this written in the spirit realm? Was this permitted for preparation?" Sometimes, God allows you to face certain situations because:

- He's preparing you for a breakthrough
- He's aligning your faith to His word
- He wants to expose and defeat the enemy's agenda

So don't panic at a negative report. Ask instead: "Lord, is this from You—or from the enemy?" "What are You saying about this situation?"



Why You Need a Relationship with God

ou can't discern between God's voice and the enemy's lies without relationship. You might say: "I read the Bible", "I listen to sermons" That's good. But the real question is: Have you encountered God personally? Has He spoken to you directly about your life? If you know what God has said, you'll know when a report is false. But if you lack that connection, you will accept anything said to you, even if it's not aligned with God's plan.

Why You Must Be Spiritually Sensitive

hen you don't know what God is saying: You panic, You accept defeat, You believe lies, You become spiritually passive, But when God speaks and you listen, it builds spiritual confidence. You'll say:

- "This is not my end."
- "This is not what God said."
- "I reject this report in Jesus' name!"

Sometimes the enemy sends false reports to:

- Distract you from your promise
- Discourage you before your breakthrough
- Discredit what God already told you

Biblical Reference: The Twelve Spies (Numbers 13:25–33)

God promised the Israelites the land of Canaan. But when the spies returned, ten gave a negative report. They said, "The land is good, but there are giants!" The people became afraid and doubted God's promise. Only Joshua and Caleb spoke in faith. They remembered what God had said. They trusted in God's report, not man's.

The Lesson: Know What God Has Told You

f you haven't heard from God, you won't have the motivation to reject negative reports. But if God has spoken a word over vour: Health, Marriage, Career, Finances, Destiny, ...then stand on that word—no matter what the physical realm says. So I ask you: What has God told you? What did He say before this situation arose? Have you written it down? Do you believe it? If God has said it, then the negative report will not prevail. Just like Abraham held on to God's word even when Sarah laughed in disbelief, you too must cling to God's promises. What Is God Saying Your relationship with God will determine how much you trust His Word. Whenever I receive a negative report, I don't just panic—I ask God: "Father, is this Your report? What is the Spirit saying concerning this physical report?" Yes, physical realities affect our lives. When one area of your life is off, the consequences often manifest physically. But I always return to the Spirit, asking: "Lord, what are You saying about this?" Why? Because God can overrule any physical verdict. His perspective overrides the report of men. And if I know what God sees and says concerning a matter, then I know how to respond in faith.

Seeing Through God's Eyes

Remember when the Israelites were being chased by the Egyptians, and the Red Sea was before them? Moses turned to God in desperation—not just to complain, but to ask: "Lord, what do You say concerning this?" Though Moses saw an obstacle, he wanted to know what God saw. That's what made the difference. This is echoed in Ezekiel's vision of the dry bones. God asked the prophet: "Son of man, can these bones live?" The prophet wisely replied: "Lord, only You know." This is how we should respond to negative reports:

- Ask God for His view. Don't accept man's opinion as final.
- Don't Be Shaken—Be Rooted

So when someone says:

- "You'll never get married."
- "You'll die from this sickness."
- "Your life will amount to nothing."

Go back to your altar and ask: "Lord, what do You see?" Your altar is your place of covenant. And God responds to those who have a relationship with Him, not just those who panic when trouble arises. He doesn't open doors just because you're in crisis—He opens them because of covenant.

Do You Have a Covenant With God?

God doesn't respond like a vending machine. He honors relationship. If you want Heaven to speak, ask yourself: Do I truly know God? Am I walking in alignment with Him? Have I built a covenant? If your answer is no, then don't be surprised if your prayers seem unheard. God opens the door to friends, not strangers.

When God Signs It, You're Safe

When they tell you: "You need surgery." Don't panic. Ask: "Lord, is this Your will?" If God says, "Go ahead with it," then you can go with peace—because that means He has signed it and will protect you through it. If God signs off on something: There will be victory. There will be testimony. There will be breakthrough.

Jesus Taught Us This Model

ven Jesus—God in the flesh—went to the Father and prayed: "If it is Your will, let this cup pass. But not My will—Yours be done." Three times He prayed. Not because He feared the cross, but because He wanted to know: "Father, what do You see? Are You in this?" That's what trust looks like.

Prophecy Comes with Battles

You've received a prophetic word—but your current reality contradicts it. Does that mean God lied? No. It means there are enemies assigned to fight that prophecy. Every promise from God comes with challenges. Even the Israelites, on their way to the Promised Land, had to fight to possess what God already gave them.

Stop Accepting Every Report

When you face delays, heartbreak, or disappointment, don't immediately say: "Maybe this is God's will." Ask God. Wait on His voice. Not every delay is divine. Some are distractions. When your relationship is failing—ask God: "Lord, does this relationship align with Your will for me?"



Not Every Relationship Is Divine

oo many people want God to fix relationships He never approved. For example, a woman says: "He smokes and drinks, but he's a good man. I believe God will change him." Why would God pair you with someone who is out of alignment with His Word? You're not Hosea. You are not called to marry a man as a project. God doesn't send you into darkness to "fix" someone. He calls you to light. Purpose aligns with purpose.

You Can't Pray Selfish Prayers. Some people pray: "Lord, change him for me." That's not a prayer of purpose—that's a prayer of emotional obsession. God doesn't answer selfish, soulish prayers. He answers prayers of alignment with His will.

Know the Mind of God. If you knew the mind of God: You wouldn't force relationships that go against His Word. You wouldn't stay where you're being spiritually contaminated. You wouldn't say, "If God wants me to marry him, He'll change him." God doesn't give unrefined gifts. He doesn't hand you broken things and expect you to fix them.

Don't Provoke God. Imagine knowing your earthly father doesn't like something, and still bringing it into his house. Wouldn't that provoke him? Likewise, don't bring what God hates into His temple—your life, your body, your spirit—and ask Him to bless it. "Do not test the Lord your God." If you know God dislikes sin or compromise, why are you offering it to Him in prayer and asking for His blessing?

Build the Foundation of Trust. If you want to change any negative report, you must: Build your relationship with God. Lay a strong foundation of intimacy. Pray not just for blessings, but for spiritual growth. Many problems come to distract you from praying the right prayers. The enemy knows that if you grow spiritually, you'll become unstoppable.

Hearing God is the Key

he Israelites brought down the wall of Jericho not with physical weapons—but with a word from God. They heard from God, followed His unusual instructions, and the impossible happened. Ask yourself: "What have I been hearing?" "Do I hear from God?"

Hearing God Produces Confidence. When you hear God: Your mindset changes. You stop accepting nonsense. You know what to reject and what to embrace. You operate in trust and discernment, not fear.

Finally, Don't chase every opportunity. Don't accept every diagnosis. Don't marry every "good person." Go back and ask: "Lord, what do You see?" If you build that kind of relationship, God will guide your every step. Even when storms come, you'll walk through them like fire—untouched, because He is with you.
