very day of your life, you need the truth to survive. The Bible says, "My people perish for lack of knowledge." You need knowledge to build your marriage, run your business, and succeed in every aspect of life. That's why when you dwell daily in the presence of God, He imparts knowledge to you.

Only those who truly understand who they are in the spirit can connect deeply with God and separate themselves from the crowd. Once you understand your life's pattern, you begin to discern what is beneficial to your destiny. How do you discover this pattern? It begins when you start a relationship with God. There is an overwhelming spiritual presence in God that opens your eyes to His goodness, greatness, and love. It also reveals how He feels when you carry the spirit of rejection and hold on to negative energy.

When you look up to God, you're asking Him to teach you how to walk with people. Your ability to relate with others should come from the knowledge He gives you—not from human understanding. The way God molds you becomes the model for how you relate with others. You don't marry, parent your children, or build relationships by your own wisdom. All these should be rooted in your connection with God. That's why Scripture says, "Looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith." Faith is not just belief; it is courage, focus, power, and capacity. When God becomes your reference point, His ways influence how you treat

your spouse, children, and others. Because your life is rooted in God and you walk consistently with Him, you will not fall into sin. You'll continue to shine because the life of God is at work in you. You are living God's life here on earth.

The Danger of Self-Reliance

he Bible warns, "Lean not on your own understanding." If you ignore how God molds you, how can you succeed? When God is at work in you, He instills His life in you. To reflect His image and likeness, you must allow Him to shape your character and decisions.

Walking in righteousness is living the life of God. You must sit with Him and pay attention to how He corrects, instructs, and loves you. That's where you gain wisdom, knowledge, and favor. The more you align with God's ways, the less room you leave for confusion and rejection. But when you consistently make decisions without God's leading, you open yourself to negative spiritual influences. These spirits take over, and the result is rejection.

The Smell of Rejection in the Spirit

Let me explain something profound: Only good people help others without ulterior motives. If a bad person is offering to help you, it's likely they intend to destroy or manipulate you. Genuine help is activated by a spiritual chemistry—a flow of divine favor. For many of you, there's a pattern in your bloodline—a spiritual inheritance of rejection. In the spirit, you "smell," and that odor repels favor, connection, and opportunity. 1 Corinthians 2:16 says, "To those who are perishing, we are a dreadful smell of death." Why does something dead smell? Because it has no life.

When you lack the life of God, you begin to emit a spiritual odor that leads to rejection.

When nothing is functioning in your life—your finances, relationships, or spiritual walk—you become like a dead person in the realm of the spirit. That's why you constantly face rejection.

Grace and Mercy Require Life

race and mercy only operate when there's life in you. If you carry the life of God, mercy will work. Grace will be active. Favor will find and follow you. But if the spirit of rejection is ruling your life, even your children may look at you and refuse to help you—not because they hate you, but because they subconsciously sense something is "off" in your spirit.

Rejection is spiritual. There must be something in you that activates help from others. It's like an energy exchange. When you are spiritually dead, that flow is blocked. People—even those meant to help you—will turn away because your energy repels them.

Scripture says, "Test all spirits whether they are from God." Good people with God's Spirit can sense bad energy. That's why even before you open your mouth, some may already say "no" to you—because they feel something repelling in your presence.

Perfume or Stench?

2 Corinthians 2:16 says, "To those who are being saved, we are a life-giving perfume." There's a fragrance in the spirit. When God's life is in you, favor follows you. Even the evil plans of your enemies will work out for your good—because favor surrounds you like a shield.

However, favor only works when there is life in you. Some of you are praying for favor but are contaminated by rejection. You're engaging in sexual immorality or ungodly behaviors that allow spiritual failure to transfer into you. The spirit world is very real. If you connect to failure, you embody failure. People don't want to associate with failure. Everyone is drawn to stars because stars shine. That's why people want to connect with celebrities, leaders, or influencers—they're attracted to value. You must shine to prosper. Your shine draws your blessings. The gifts of the wise men came because of the star that appeared. Every gift of God follows the star.

The Light That Attracts Destiny

Tesus Christ was located by the three wise men because a star shone above Him. That star was the signal that a King had been born. People won't notice you until your light shines. You must shine to be traceable. If there's no light in you, you remain invisible—no matter how hard you try.

When your spirit is full of negativity, you keep killing your soul with unhealthy habits, bitterness, and immorality—and yet expect favor. It doesn't work like that. Many of you are dealing with ancestral altars and generational patterns of rejection, failure, and spiritual bondage. These patterns flow through your bloodline. If your parents failed, and you haven't broken away from their path spiritually, that pattern will flow in you too.

You can't inherit success from failure unless you spiritually detach yourself. Until a child steps out of their father's house spiritually, they can't fully access the inheritance of destiny. Successful parents raise successful children, but if your lineage is bound by failure, you must be delivered from that pattern.

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Two Types of Hatred

- **1.)** Hatred for Doing Right: This is the kind of hatred Jesus experienced. He did everything right, yet people still hated Him. But despite the rejection, He still shone.
- **2.)** Hatred Caused by Negative Energy: When you're not shining and people hate you, it's often because there's something inside of you that repels them.

Ask yourself: What do I carry inside of me? There are families where nothing works. No one wants to help them—not because people are wicked, but because there is a spiritual pattern at work. That pattern creates rejection. You carry not just your family's mentality, but the very spirit behind it, and that spirit begins to possess you.

Spiritual Vagabonds

When you walk with a negative spirit, people around you begin to sense something is "off." They might not say it directly, but they feel it. You go for help, and before you even speak, they're already saying "no" in their minds. You leave confused, not knowing that what they sensed wasn't your need—it was your spirit.

Just like Cain, who killed his brother Abel, the Lord said to him: "You shall be a vagabond." Many of you are roaming in the spirit realm—directionless, like mad people. You go from place to place, job to job, person to person—no plan, no purpose, no favor. Even unbelievers can smell your spirit. Favor requires likability, but your energy repels favor.

The Life of God in You

here is a spirit that walks with you wherever you go. That spirit is either the life of God or a demonic force. When God is inside of you, everything begins to align for your good. Even the earth responds to the God within you. What you plant grows. What you speak manifests. And even when people hate you, that hatred works for your promotion—because favor is inside of you.

How do you carry the life of God? You look up to Him. You acknowledge Him as the author of your life. The author writes your story. He shapes it when you sit with Him, and He finishes it by building your capacity.

When you say, "I walk by faith," it means:

- "I walk by God."
- "I am led by God."
- "I speak by God."
- "I love by God."
- "I do business by God."

Faith is not just belief—it's divine obedience. And when you allow God to write your story, you begin to walk in alignment with heaven's agenda.



God Uses What He Owns

hen your body becomes a living sacrifice, God begins to use and protect it. If He uses you, He will guard you. But many of you want God's protection while indulging in sexual immorality. How can God protect a body He doesn't own? You pray for success, guidance, and favor—but your body is disconnected from God's Spirit. That's not how divine alignment works. When you dwell in God's presence, He begins to fill you with Himself. As He fills you, you reflect Him more and more.

When God is truly in you, you won't face rejection. Even when someone helps you once, they're inclined to help again—only if they see something in you that connects to them. Helping flows from mutual energy. The giver's spirit must resonate with the receiver's spirit. If the flow is broken, the giving stops.

Don't Waste Your Oil on the Wrong People

ome of you keep begging people for help, not realizing they're only taking advantage of your desperation. You present your ideas, and they steal them. You think they want to help you, but they're gathering your wisdom and using it for themselves. And because you lacked spiritual wisdom—you didn't document or protect your ideas—they run with it and leave you behind. You don't even have the resources to sue them. That's how many of you have lost your vision—by trusting the wrong people without seeking God first.

The Spirit of God was already warning you: "Don't connect with them." But you ignored it. Now you've been used, discarded, and left empty.

The Life of God in You

hen you truly know who you are, you won't give yourself away so easily. Even in the midst of pain or desperation, you'll protect your gift. A man's gift makes room for him. That means your gift is the key to your destiny. Don't trade it for cheap pleasures. Don't give it up for marriage, money, or validation. Esau traded his birthright for food. Many of you have done the same—giving up your divine inheritance for sexual pleasure or short-term comfort.

God will never tempt you beyond your capacity. So don't say, "I had no choice." You always have a choice. Desperation kills capacity. Birthright should never be exchanged for a bowl of temporary satisfaction.

Firstborn Anointing & the Spirit of Herod

When you carry greatness, Herod will rise. The three wise men sought Jesus because of His greatness—but Herod sought Him to kill Him.

Herod always attacks the firstborn, the first manifestation of your breakthrough. That first relationship, the first business deal, the first testimony—Herod wants to destroy it. Because the firstborn opens the womb for other blessings. It is the door. If Herod can kill that first blessing, he has locked the door to the rest.

So, when you encounter God and start seeing results, be wise. The attack is coming. Be like a serpent—wise. Be calm like a dove. Stay alert. Guard what God has birthed in you.

The Vision: Building on Water

had a revelation: Everywhere was flooded, like a river. It reminded me of Makoko in Lagos. I was trying to protect every member of my family—looking for a way to get them to dry land. The main door was submerged, so I created a new path. I started filling the river with stones, making dry ground over the water.

Suddenly, a man appeared. He looked like a soldier, though he didn't wear a uniform. Spiritually, I discerned he was a military man. He declared, "I'm in charge now. I rule everything."

But I asked myself: After I built this—after all the struggle—how can someone just come and claim control?

Don't Let Them Rule What They Didn't Build

Many of you have suffered, labored, and built something meaningful from nothing. Yet, someone shows up and wants to take control. They weren't there when you were struggling. They didn't cry with you. They didn't help you climb. But now they want to rule you.

This is how many women are treated: a man sees the results of your pain and wants to dominate you without investing anything. Men too—take note. Some women only show up after the hard part is over. f they didn't build with you, they can't rule over you. No one should intimidate or control you where God has empowered and sustained you. Let no one reap where they didn't sow. Don't let anyone lay on the bed you built, only to tell you to sleep on the floor.

Remain Focused on God, Not the Helpers

hen God brings you to a place of visibility, stay connected to Him. Don't let people manipulate or control you because they claim to be your helper.

Here's the truth: if God sent someone to help you, it was never about them—it was about God seeing your need and using them as a vessel. Some of you get carried away by the helper and lose sight of the Source. You start fasting and praying for your helper more than you pray for yourself. You go to the mountain and cry for their prosperity—but forget your own purpose.

That's not how it works. Your prayers didn't build their success. They were already blessed. You didn't even pray like that for yourself.

Don't Be Distracted by Manipulative Helpers

Many helpers will say, "Tell me your idea, tell me your plan." Then they steal it. You trusted them blindly. You had no wisdom, no spiritual discernment. You didn't know how to protect your gift. They ran with your vision because they had the resources—and you didn't.

You trusted them more than you trusted God. You ignored the Holy Spirit saying, "Don't connect." And now, your ideas are gone. They're prospering from your revelation, and you're left dry.

Your Gift Is Sacred—Don't Sell It

When you know who you are in the spirit, you don't give up your gift out of desperation. Your gift makes room for you. Your gift is your wealth, your connection, your favor, your future. But many of

you gave it away for: A marriage proposal, A job contract A moment of pleasure

You sold your birthright just like Esau. And what happened? He sought the blessing later—but it was too late. His father said, "I have already given it to your brother." That's how many of you are walking around empty, bitter, and lost—because you gave up what God gave you. And now, you're chasing shadows, moving like vagabonds, angry at everyone, wondering why things aren't working.

Destiny Requires Spiritual Discipline

any of you are suffering not because of demonic attacks—but because you traded your identity for convenience. You're struggling financially, mentally, and emotionally—not because you lack potential, but because you didn't protect your spirit. You let pleasures kill your destiny.

A mad man eats from dustbins and wears rags. That's what spiritual madness looks like—settling for anything, following anything, wearing anything. When you lose God's presence, you lose everything that's tied to your destiny.



Prophetic Consciousness: "There's a Word Over My Life"

Whenever sin tries to enter, say to yourself:

"There's a prophecy over my life. I cannot fail God. I will not disappoint heaven."

Be aware of what God has spoken over you. Every action should be filtered through the awareness of your divine assignment. Your body is not just flesh—it's the vessel God needs to bless you, marry you, heal you, and raise you. Without God in your body, how can your body function?

They live, but they've given up on life. Why? Because they've lost connection to God. They traded destiny for convenience. They sold purpose for temporary relief.

You Need More Than Just Life—You Need a Life That Works

any of you have sold your purpose for money, sex, or attention. Then you wonder why favor won't come. Favor flows through alignment. You can't expect divine favor while walking in rebellion.

You must live in the Spirit if you want to conceive something greater. That's what happened to Mary. The angel told her, "You have found favor with God." Why? Because she kept herself pure. She looked up to God.

Herod Always Chases Greatness

When you carry greatness, expect Herod. Herod is in your family, Herod is in your workplace, Herod is in your friendships. Herod targets the firstborn—the first good thing that happens to you. That first opportunity, first open door, first testimony—that's what Herod tries to kill. Why? Because the firstborn carries the future. The firstborn opens the womb for the rest.

The Presence of God Is Your Door

When you lose the Spirit of God, you lose the key that opens every door in your life. He is the first and the last, the opener of destinies. Without Him, you are a spiritual mad person, wearing rags, eating from dustbins—settling for rejection and failure.
